

LWPS Nursery – Literacy and Numeracy Home Learning Grid

Choose 2 tasks to complete each day [Monday – Friday]. Colour in each task when you think your child can do this with confidence!

Count forwards to 5/10/15/20 – Use songs to help you such as ‘1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive...’	Go over the alphabet sounds and find the first sound in your name	Read a book together and talk about your favourite part	Sing the toothbrushing song when cleaning your teeth	Count backwards from 5/10 – Use songs to help you such as ‘5 Little Monkeys jumping on the bed’	Make a number line using your number cards – 0-5 then 0-10	Play a game of shops using coins and tins etc in the house – Can you take turns of being the shopper and the shopkeeper?
Play dominos/look at a dice – Can you count the number of spots? Enjoy different games that use a dice together.	Look at your number flashcards – Can you read the numbers and clap that many out?	Go on a Spring hunt! Look for signs of Spring such as flowers, buds, blossom trees, birds etc.	Draw some ladybirds and add on different amounts of spots within 10.	Read a story and retell this in your own words – what happened in this story? (beginning, middle and end)	Sing some of your favourite nursery rhymes together and watch online versions. *Can you hear any rhyming words?	Go on a number hunt! Try to spot numbers around the house, on doors, on buses and write these down.
Go on a shape hunt! Can you find a circle, triangle square or a rectangle?	Make an obstacle course that allows you to jump, walk forwards, backwards, sideways etc.	Research your favourite animal – where does it come from? What does it eat? Where does it live? *Can you make a poster or a small book about it together?	Make your name using your alphabet sound cards	Follow the recipe to make some playdough together. Make different shapes/letters and numbers together.	Make a model in your house – talk about what you used, what you’ve made and any other important details.	Read a book together and talk about the setting – “Where does this story happen?”
Look at different types of clocks in your house – Sing Hickory Dickory Clock and look at the hands/numbers.	Read a story together and draw your favourite part. Talk about your picture.	Play with water in the sink. Can you make the cup full, half full, empty? Try this with different objects!	Work with a grown up to bake or cook something in your house. Can you measure using teaspoons/tablespoons and cupful?	Read a book together and identify who the main character(s) were.	Write your name and go over this with lots of different colours to make rainbow writing!	Make a den together. Try to use different resources around the house/garden and test who can fit inside!
